OF CARLOS MUNIZ (as recipients are aware, CARLOS MUNIZ VARELA was assassinated in April 1979, by anti-Castro terrorists in San Juan, Puerto Rico, because of his pro-Castro stance. MUNIZ had been president of Viajes Varadero, a San Juan travel agency given the exclusive right by the Cuban Government to arrange travel to Cuba for Cuban exiles.) (S) (u)

NYO's canvass of logical sources and assets did not reflect any pertinent information regarding ALZAGA and FRAGA. (S) (u)

NYO indices regarding Viajes Varadero and Servicios Comunitarios, Inc., were negative. (S) (u)

In view of the fact that NYO has completed its investigation, it is placing this matter in an RUC status. (U)

In referenced teletype, the NYO was requested to conduct indices checks regarding captioned subjects and to canvass biological sources and assets to ascertain any pertinent information concerning the above subjects.

NYfile 2-745 reflects the following information regarding ALZAGA:

On June 18, 1979, one [redacted] a member of the Coordinacion de Organizaciones Revolucionarias Unidas (Cooridation of United Revolutionary Organizations) (CORU) in San Juan, Puerto Rico, was observed by Special Agents (SAs) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), boarding an Eastern Airlines Flight 903 from San Juan, with destination to Miami at approximately 1:15 PM. *STU*

[redacted] allegedly met with one [redacted] concerning a plot to assassinate one, RAUL ALZAGA. *STU PK*

NYfile 2-716 reflects the following:

On 10/17/79, RAUL ALZAGA MANRESA, Vice President, VIAJES VARADERO, San Juan, Puerto Rico, advised that he was in New York City with RICARDO FRAGA DEL VALLE, during the weekend of October 12 through October 15, 1979. While in New York, they stayed with a friend, ARMANDO GARCIA at GARCIA's apartment, 5412 94th Street, Apartment 2B, Queens, New York, and used a car belonging to another friend, RAFAEL BETENCOURT, Vice President of Mar Azul Travel Agency, 54th Street, New York City. *STU*
